JOB PURPOSE:

The CHILL Assistant supports the lead academic coach(es) to engage students in healthy life choices, help organize culturally-rich family nights, model healthy values, and nurture caring adult/youth relationships. The CHILL (Creating Healthy Inclusive Learning Lifestyles) time after-school program meets four times a week and each session includes four components: a snack, an outdoor/indoor recreation activity, a collaborative circle time, and a fun, engaging hands-on activity in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts or Math (STEAM) or Integrative Youth Development (IYD). Lessons will tie in school topics through outdoor recreation, artistic expression, and scientific exploration, with an emphasis on healthy life choices for kids and pre-teens.
