Collaborate with elementary (K-6) teachers, administrators, students, families, and counselors to advance culturally-grounded and trauma-informed support for social emotional learning, STEAM activities, and academic achievement. Contribute ideas and resources for teachers to align instruction with Alaska Cultural Standards. Organize and provide effective on-site and remote activities to help advance mindfulness and self-regulation, positive youth development, and successful academic behaviors. Responsible for student monitoring, instructional support, follow-up classroom implementation from professional development trainings, and educational planning. Gather data and provide to director and evaluators. This position is .50 FTE for each of three sites: Port Graham, Nanwalek, and Tebughna Schools.

Qualifications

- Min. Bachelor's degree in Education or related field
- Clear background check
- Understanding of cultural norms, youth development, ACE's, trauma and impact on learning
- Understanding of best practices in instruction including classroom management, student engagement and motivation, differentiated instruction, and assessment
- Experience with multi-grade classrooms in a rural setting
- Excellent verbal and interpersonal skills
- Ability to communicate among district counseling services, cultural consultant, students, families, and teachers in best interest of the student
- Experience with STEAM education (science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics)
- Understanding of academic behaviors (attendance, engagement, self-advocacy, questioning...)
